Among the reasons are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Technological Obsolescence</u> – Technology eventually outpaced the project, as the use of cellular phones became more common.</li> <li>• <u>No legal backbone</u> – The Municipal Telephone Act (RA 6849), which acts as the legal backbone for the project, expired last March 1999 – resulting in the dissolution of the MTPO Project Management Office.</li> <li>• <u>Lack of thorough study resulting to failure</u> – It proved to be a losing financial venture because most of the lines were installed in areas where poverty was so pervasive that people could barely afford three meals a day, much less pay for phone calls.</li> <li>• <u>Gross mismanagement</u> – On July 26, 2006, Senator Miriam Defensor-Santiago called for an investigation of TSB, citing gross mismanagement as the cause of failure of the project.</li> </ul>
